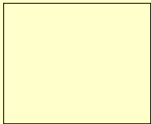

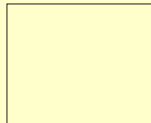

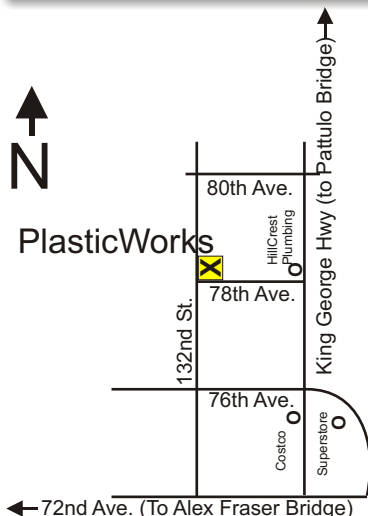

E6000 Caulkings

A 30% solids adhesive caulking that bonds reliably to both porous and non-porous materials. It's paintable, self levelling, and can be used as a sealant or even a high-build electrical insulating coating. The E6000 family also has excellent cohesive strength, meaning the glue line won't tear from itself. The same great properties are also available in a thicker, anti-sag formulation (E6100) and a UV stabilized formulation (E6800). A 3.7oz tube is available for small jobs.

Sika-Flex 291

A premium 1 part, moisture cure, marine grade urethane caulking. Used on boats for bedding (glueing) hardware and accessories, plus sealing seams on hatches and windows. Sikaflex caulking is equally at home above and below the waterline. Sikaflex 291 is also sandable and paintable. It is available in fast cure or long-open-time varieties.

PlasticWorks is proud to be a distributor of genuine Velcro brand hook and loop fasteners. We carry the adhesive backed Velcro in 3/4", 1" and 2" widths, stocking both black and white. We also carry the versatile UltraMate (Hook 1 side- Loop the other), and heavy-duty 3M Duo-Lock (Hook on Hook) fastening system. Here at PlasticWorks, we use Velcro for signage, price tag holders, mounting access panels, and even holding our pens so they're near the saw! The possibilities are endless.

Double Sided Tapes

Foam Mounting Tape

Closed cell polyethylene foam coated both sides with a high performance rubber adhesive. Excellent initial tack, holding power and shear strength.

Cloth-Reinforced Carpet Tape

Thin, flexible and gummy tape with very good adhesion and very high initial tack. The cloth allows removal with minimal residue. We use it regularly in our shop.

VHB Clear Acrylic Tape (Very High Bond)

An amazing tape! Excellent clarity, high tack and high strength make it great for mounting acrylic. It comes in 36 foot rolls (longer available), in .020 thick (1/4" wide) and .040" thick (1/2" wide). This tape's thickness allows it to conform to textured surfaces.

Clear Polyester Tape

We have two tapes featuring the adhesion strength of acrylic on a clear polyester carrier. One is UV stable and recommended for use outdoors. The other is best used indoors, but less expensive. Both have good temperature resistance.
